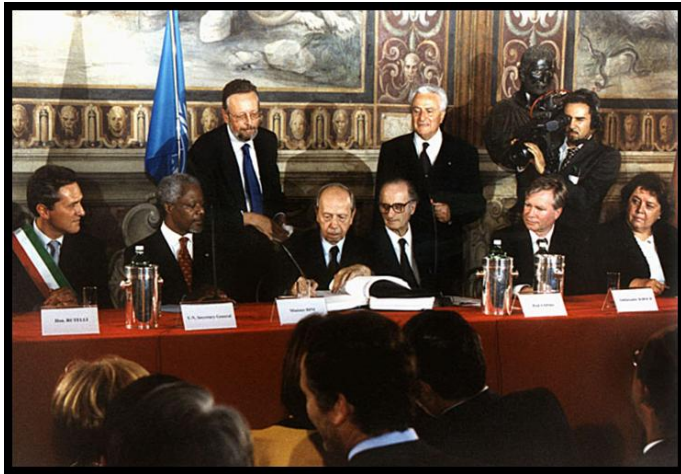


10th Anniversary of the Rome Statute

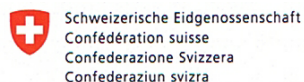
